Report on E-week 2018

The Entrepreneurship Development Cell (Sphuran) of B. P. Poddar Institute of Management & Technology organized 'E-week 2018' at the Institute premises in collaboration with National Entrepreneurship Network (NEN), Wadhvani Foundation during February 10-16, 2018 with an objective to create a networked platform and ecosystem for early-stage entrepreneurs and to instill entrepreneurship culture among the students. During this period four different events were organized- E-talk, E-quiz, B Plan, E-ship Competition.

E-talk was organized on February 10, 2018. Mr. Debdeep Roy, Founder and CEO, Cleonix Technologies and an alumnus shared his journey to become a successful entrepreneur before the present students and motivated them to become job-providers not job-seekers. Debdyut Hajra and Tushar Dhanuka, our final year students and former E-leaders also shared their experience they gathered during their tenure.

E-quiz was a quiz completion related to business and entrepreneurship which was held on February 13, 2018. Total seventeen groups consisting of three members each participated in this event. Bhavya Kumari, Anjali Kumari and Debasmita Pramanik, students of ECE Department grabbed the first position. Group consisting of Mukund Fatehpuria, Neha Agarwal and Anika Agarwal, students of CSE Department stood second and Sharmi Das, Riya Saha and Pooja Kumari, students of IT Department secured third position.

B Plan Competition was held on February 15, 2018 at the Institutional Seminar Hall. Total fifteen teams from different departments participated in that event. Mr. Abhijit Gupta from Humanities Department, Ms. Susmita Biswas from ECE Department and Mr. Subhashis Mallick from the Department of Computer Applications acted as judges of the said event. Committee members and audience were overwhelmed by the outstanding business plans presented by the participants. Finally IT 4th year students grabbed the first position with their new idea 'DEVI'. ECE 3rd year students secured the second position with their business concept 'Pied paper' and IT 3rd year students secured 3rd position with their idea 'Translo'.

E-ship competition was one of the attractive events which took place on February 16, 2018. It was a software, hardware or hybrid prototype model competition in working mode with commercial aspect. To develop the team spirit among the students, the competition was organised in groups with maximum four members in a group. The participants came up with fantastic working models like 'Obstacle Avoiding Car', 'Smart Glass', 'Surveillance of Smart Car Control by DTMF', Alarming Distance Meter etc. The competition was judged by Dr. Ivy Majumdar, Head of the Department, Electronics and Communication Engineering.

Faculty and Student Members of the ED Cell organized the events successfully. Regular classes were held as per schedule.
