### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

#### **CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN AICTE APPROVED TECHNICAL INSTITUTIONS**

It is brought to the notice of all AICTE approved Institutions, students and other various stakeholders that ragging is a criminal offence and AICTE has already framed its Regulation which has been notified vide F.No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated July 1, 2009 (available on AICTE [web portal aicte-india.org](http://www.aicte-india.org)) on curbing the menace of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institutions, in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institutions.

The above Regulation is mandatory and applies to all AICTE approved Institutions. Therefore, all these Institutions should take necessary steps for its proper implementation such as: -

- Constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad,
- Obtaining Undertakings at the time of admission and allotment of Hostel accommodation,
- Dedicated cadre of Warden(s),
- Appointing Professional Counselor(s) for Freshers,
- Erection of Posters/Banners displaying provisions of law, punishments, etc.

Any violation of AICTE Regulations as cited above by an AICTE approved Institution or an instance wherein any Institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or fails to act in accordance with these regulations or fails to punish perpetrators or incidents of ragging suitably, AICTE shall call for punitive action against erring Institutions as per provisions of the Approval Process Handbook.
